- In the spring of 2017, 70% of students in grades K-6 will be at or above benchmark on the FAST Adaptive aReading assessment.

- For the 2016-2017 school year, 60% of students will achieve their growth targets as identified by the fall to spring iReady Math assessment.
- For the 2016-2017 school year, 73% of students will achieve their growth targets as identified by the fall to spring Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment.
- For the 2016-2017 school year, 80% of Kindergarten and First grade students will be at or above benchmark as demonstrated on the spring FAST aReading assessment.
- For the 2016-2017 school year, to have fewer than 3 official reports to the administration of a bullying/harassment incident.
